## **Annual Inspections**

It is inspection season at Village Green – Maintenance will be doing annual inspections on the same day that FireGuard will be checking fire extinguishers. The set dates for annual inspections are Monday, October 28<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday, October 29<sup>th</sup>. Maintenance will be checking smoke detectors, CO2 detectors, outside shut off valves, and furnace filters. If there is a furnace filter that needs to be changed and member does not have one available, member will be charged \$10 for installation of a new filter. A notice will go out to each unit as this date approaches.

## **Outdoor Lighting**

Members have contacted the office regarding several light poles that have been out, and we have reached an agreement with Superior Lighting to start changing lamps that have been out for a long while.

## **Furnace Inspections**

A-1 did a great job on the installs of furnaces in the last month. Ben and Jackie with A-1 are scheduled to start their techs on furnace inspections this month, checking each furnace to ensure the safety of all units.

#### **Pet Forms**

Please submit updated vaccination forms for your pets if you haven't yet – we are missing several updated vaccination forms and would like to have those in. Notices will be sent out to those who do not provide proper documentation. It is important to have your pets get their shots on a yearly basis and is part of the occupancy agreement at Village Green.
